4. **EKSAMENREËLS / EXAM RULES**

Maak u self bekend met onderstaande eksamenreëls wat van toepassing is op alle grade.

(Neem kennis: Offisiële departementele dokument, slegs beskikbaar in Engels.)

Please familiarise yourself with the exam rules that will be applicable to all grades.

(Please note: Official departmental document, hence only available in English.)
Examination Rules:

- The following rules and procedures need to be followed and adhered to strictly as stipulated by the **Dept. of Education**. Routine check-ups will occur unannounced on a daily basis during all sessions.
- No late coming during exams will be allowed. If you are late, you will have to complete a
 written warning indicating the reasons for being late before you are allowed into the
 examination room. Your parents will be contacted immediately. If you know you are going
 to be late, please let your parents accompany you to the school, or phone the school
 immediately.
- 1st Session starts strictly at 7h30 and 2nd session at 11h00. You must be seated 30min before the exam commences to complete all relevant documentation.
- If late coming is repeated for a second time, you will lose your privilege to study at home and you will study at school. We will then immediately schedule a meeting with your parents before you are allowed to **complete any further exams**.
- Appearance must, under all circumstances, adhere to the school rules as stated in the school prospectus.
- During your exam session you are **not allowed** to go to the bathroom. Plan and go to the bathroom before school. If you have a medical problem, please submit a Dr's letter not older than 3 months to your register teacher.
- Food and drinks are not allowed in the classrooms. (Not even water)
- No container (not even see-through) for stationery is allowed. (Lip balm and lip ice containers
 are not allowed). Tipp-ex may not be in your possession at all.
- Access cards need to be placed on the right-hand side of the table before the session starts.
- Disruption of an exam session:
 - Talking at any given time while inside the classroom. Once you enter the class NO form of communication will be tolerated.
 - Any form of communication e.g.: looking around, laughing, or any non-verbal communication with any person in the class.
 - Making noises / sounds / whistling.
 - Any "reaction" due to someone coughing or sneezing will count as collective disruption and result in your immediate removal from the exam room!!!

- Leaving or standing up while the teachers are busy taking in the question papers after an exam.
- No cell phones are allowed within the exam rooms.
- o Any misconduct involving cheating.

ANY of the above-mentioned actions will immediately result in an internal school hearing, NO WARNINGS NEEDED!!!

We take this matter very seriously to ensure you successfully complete your exams without any complications.
